### **487<sup>th</sup> Bomb Group holds Memorial Dedication**

Pooler, Ga. – On Saturday, July 17, 2010, World War II Veterans and members from the 487<sup>th</sup> Bomb Group Association will dedicate a new monument for the 487<sup>th</sup> Bomb Group in the Mighty Eighth Air Force Museum's Memorial Gardens. A dedication ceremony will be held at 10 am in the Museum's Chapel of Fallen Eagles. The monument will be unveiled directly after the dedication ceremony.

Activated in 1942 in Savannah, GA the Eighth Air Force was a critical strike element in World War II and remains an active force today. The Mighty Eighth Air Force Museum is one of the world's most powerful Museum experiences as it honors the Mighty Eighth's proud legacy by preserving the stories of courage, character and patriotism displayed by the men and women of the Eighth Air Force from World War II to present.
