Community Appreciation Days in June at the Mighty Eighth Air Force Museum

(Pooler, GA) The Mighty Eighth Air Force Museum is launching a new initiative to encourage local citizens to take advantage of what is right here at home. The Museum has dedicated June as *Community Appreciation Month* to the Coastal Empire and Low County, and has reduced its regular admission rate of \$10 for adults and \$6 for kids to only \$5 for adults and \$3 for kids.

The Museum is restoring its B-17 in honor of the original, "City of Savannah" which was the 5000th plane to have been processed through Hunter Army Airfield during World War II. The "City of Savannah" is on display inside the Museum's Combat Gallery. Come be a part of history in the making!

Activated in 1942 in Savannah, GA the Eighth Air Force was an important strike element in World War II and remains an active force today. The Mighty Eighth Air Force Museum honors the Mighty Eighth's proud legacy by preserving the stories of courage, character and patriotism displayed by the men and women of the Eighth Air Force from World War II to the present.

Just minute's from historic Savannah the Museum is located at 175 Bourne Avenue in Pooler, right off I-95 at Exit 102. The Mighty Eighth Air Force Museum is open daily from 9AM until 5PM except New Year's Day, Easter, Thanksgiving, and Christmas.
