Pearl Harbor Day Memorial Service at the Mighty Eighth Air Force Museum

Activated in 1942, only days after the attack on Pearl Harbor, in Savannah, GA the Eighth Air Force was a critical strike element in World War II and remains an active force today. The Mighty Eighth Air Force Museum is one of the world's most powerful Museum experiences as it honors the Mighty Eighth's proud legacy by preserving the stories of courage, character and patriotism displayed by the men and women of the Eighth Air Force from World War II to present.
