Pooler, Ga. – On Thursday, November 11, 2009, come remember those who served our country at the Mighty Eighth Air Force Museum. All military veterans and active duty military will be recognized. Military veterans will receive a special admission rate of \$5 to the Museum.

It is the perfect time to come see the Museum's newest addition a WWII era B-17 bomber. The airplane named, "*City of Savannah*" is on display in the Museum's Combat Gallery while undergoing a complete restoration.

Activated in 1942 in Savannah, GA the Eighth Air Force was a critical strike element in World War II and remains an active force today. The Mighty Eighth Air Force Museum is one of the world's most powerful Museum experiences as it honors the Mighty Eighth's proud legacy by preserving the stories of courage, character and patriotism displayed by the men and women of the Eighth Air Force from World War II to present.
